
As a member of West

New Districts in Place for Equal Representation

Our cooperative has gained service territory and members within the last six years by expanding our fiber network to neighboring rural Wadena and rural Staples areas. These newest members of the association were able to participate in the annual meeting and election as well as earn capital credits for their patronage. However, because the cooperative's directors represented telephone exchanges, the new Wadena and Staples members didn't have a director representing them, and they weren't eligible to serve on any committees or the board.



Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws that allowed for the creation of districts were approved by members at last year's annual meeting. New districts that cover all the added territory and allow members equitable representation were recently approved by the Board of Directors. Now, members in Wadena and Staples are also eligible to serve on the Nominations & Elections Committee and the Board of Directors.

What's New with West Central TV?

Every three years, we complete a negotiations process for retransmission of broadcast networks. Last year we completed a three-year term for most of the networks. The rate increases that the networks imposed for carriage of their channels resulted in a Broadcast TV Surcharge on your bill in July 2021. This month you'll notice the surcharge is higher as a direct result of rate increases from the broadcast networks.

NBC Sports has been discontinued by parent company NBCU as of January 1, 2022. As a result, much of their sporting programs have been shifted to USA on channel 19 in standard definition or channel 220 in HD.

If you're a cowboy and western fan, you'll love INSP's new lineup of shows including *Gunsmoke*, *Big Valley* and *The Cowboy Way*. Movie marathons with John Wayne and Gary Cooper, plus originals like *Ultimate Cowboy Showdown* and *Wild West Chronicles*, will give you binge-worthy TV.

FRS College Scholarship Program

The FRS College Scholarship program provides \$2,000 and the sponsoring NTCA member company provides \$500 for a total of \$2,500. In additional to the FRS general scholarships, FRS has the following named scholarships:

WCTA Scholarship Program

High school seniors whose parents are cooperative members are encouraged to apply for one of eight scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each. The application deadline is April 1, 2022. Our cooperative status allows us to fund our scholarship program in part through unclaimed capital credits.

Minnesota Telecom Alliance Foundation Scholarships

The MTA Foundation will award six scholarships to high school seniors graduating in 2022. Each scholarship will be in the amount of \$2,000. There are two types of scholarships this year:

- One \$2,000 Telecom Scholarship: To be eligible, applicants must be majoring in either Telecommunications or Information Technology (IT) at a university, college, or technical college and be a Minnesota resident.
- One of five \$2,000 General Scholarships: To be eligible, applicants must be attending post-secondary education at a university, college, or technical college, be a Minnesota resident, and the applicant's family must subscribe to at least one service from an MTA member company.

Once completed, the application must be printed and submitted to WCTA by February 18, 2022.

2nd Year or Beyond Scholarship

Current college students are urged to apply for a \$1,000 scholarship through the 2nd Year or Beyond Scholarship. Students who graduated from high school and are from any one of the telephone exchanges of WCTA currently attending 2nd year or beyond higher education are eligible. **Past scholarship winners are also eligible.** The application deadline is May 27, 2022.
