The 72nd annual meeting was held May 16 at the Sebeka High School Auditorium. Board president Bruce Kinnunen talked about the growth of the cooperative over the past five years, which included adding over 1,100 members in rural Wadena and Staples. This growth prompted a shift in board representation of the members from telephone exchanges to districts. Members are now represented by districts. Kinnunen closed his report by announcing that just under \$500,000 in capital credits will be paid to members this year.

CEO Chad Bullock discussed the financial health of the cooperative, updated the membership on upgrades to the network and highlighted the full lineup of managed technology solutions available to the region.

Brent Christensen, President of the Minnesota Telecom Alliance, gave his perspective of the state of our industry. He also announced that Sebeka High School senior Eion Ness was awarded a special \$2,000 Jon Tollefson Technology Scholarship through the MTA (Minnesota Telecom Alliance) Foundation.

Robert Weaver, Secretary of the Board representing District 2 and Dave Pulju, Vice President of the Board representing District 5 both ran uncontested, and as such, will remain on the board for another three years.
