#### Happy Grandparents Day to Grand Folks



### We're Celebrating Co-op Month


Each October, cooperatives all across America, including West Central Telephone, celebrate the role, accomplishments, and contributions of our nation's co-ops.

## BUSINESS SPOTLIGHT: Fitness 71

Fitness 71 is located at 112 Aspen Ave S in Menahga, along the Hwy 71 corridor (which inspired its name). The fitness center opened its doors in February of this year and provides 24/7 access to members. Fitness 71 is for adults 18 and older, although under a family membership plan, kids who are at least 16 years old can join with a notarized waiver from their parents. There are no long-term contracts or no sign-up fees — just simple monthly or yearly plans.

When designing the gym, owner Trinity Junes sought out opinions and suggestions from many local people. "I tried to make the most of the space. I considered community recommendations on equipment and layout of the gym. Now I love getting feedback from members on ways to improve the gym as it grows."

The gym features lockers and a shower area along with state-ofthe-art equipment including four treadmills, two exercise bikes, a rowing machine, an elliptical, two squat racks with bench presses, cable machines, a dip station and free weights and benches. There's also a filtered water system that dispenses hot, cold or room temperature water and ice, as well as two TVs for members to watch while working out.

Trinity relies on WCTA for surveillance with security cameras and for the internet with Wi-Fi he provides for members to use.
